Stadium – The 2,200-seat outdoor stadium boasts an internationally-sanctioned eight-lane, 400-metre track, regulation size football/soccer field, lighting for night play, an electronic P.A. and scoreboard system. Call 416-338-3349 for stadium/field reservations.

Playing Fields – Three lit softball diamonds, one lit baseball diamond, four regulation playing fields (one with night lights) and one practice field offer the perfect location for tournament play for softball, slo-pitch and soccer and special events. Call 416-394-8514 to book a field.
